

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR LIST OF PUBLICATIONS

Instructions to applicants

Please read these instructions carefully before starting your application.

Evaluation of scholarships/grants applications is based on an objective assessment of the applicant's scientific publications.

Points are awarded according to the following scoring system:

	1 st or last author (Number of points)	Any other place in the authors' list (Number of points)
Paper published in a journal indexed in PubMed	20	10
Book or chapter published by an international publisher	16	8
Paper published in a journal NOT indexed in PubMed	10	5
Book or chapter published by a national publisher	8	4
Oral/Other presentation presented in an international congress	2	0
Oral/Other presentation presented in a national congress	1	0

To be eligible to apply:

- Trainees or certified Specialists in Dermatology and/or Venereology: a minimum of 5 points is required.
- PhD Students or Scientists holding a PhD degree in Dermatology and/or Venereology and being currently engaged in full-time research in the same field are required to reach a minimum of 25 points.

General Requirements:

- ✓ The given template must be used to prepare the list of publications.
- ✓ Records must be added, within the relevant section, in a numerical order (1; 2; 3; ...).
- ✓ There is no limit to the number of records you can add per section. You are welcome to include as many entries as needed in each section.
- ✓ The list must be self-scored by adding the relevant points for each record in the dedicated column, at the end of each section and at the bottom of the list (total sum).
- ✓ The applicant must mention clearly at the beginning of the list of publications if their surname has changed over their training/publication period.
- ✓ Only lists of publications that are properly completed, self-scored and uploaded in the requested format within the deadline are taken into consideration.

The applicant is solely responsible for ensuring that all the above requirements are met by the deadline. If there is any uncertainty, it is strongly recommended to contact scholarship@eadv.org at least 5 working days before the deadline to allow sufficient time for assistance.

Paper published in a journal indexed in PubMed / Paper published in a journal NOT indexed in PubMed

- ✓ Properly described references must be included: full details of all authors, title of article, journal name, publication year and page number(s) must be displayed.
- ✓ Only articles that have been published will be accepted. Contributions that have been submitted or are 'in press' (including e-publications) but have not yet been published by the time of application will not be accepted (unless you can provide the DOI number).
- ✓ Web publications are not accepted.
- ✓ No special points are assigned to the corresponding author (if he/she is not first/last author).
- ✓ First and last co-authors may assign themselves the maximum points, but this must be clearly stated within the references.

Book or chapter published by an international publisher / Book or chapter published by a national publisher

- ✓ Properly described references must be included: full details of all authors, title of chapter, book name, publication year, page number(s) must be displayed.
- ✓ Only books that have been published will be accepted. Contributions that have been submitted or are 'in press' (including e-publications) but have not yet been published by the time of application will not be accepted (unless you can provide the ISBN number).

Oral/Other presentation presented in an international congress / Oral/Other presentation presented in a national congress

- ✓ Properly described references must be included: full details of all authors, title of presentation, full name of conference (avoid abbreviations), venue (city) and dates must be displayed.
- ✓ Presentations are given points only if the applicant was the first or last author and only such presentations should be included in the list.
- ✓ For each record it must be specified whether the presentation was an oral or other presentation (e.g. poster presentation, video presentation/showcase, ...).
Delivered lectures (if quoted in the official event's scientific programme) at international, national, and regional scientific events can be included within this section.
- ✓ Presentations must be personally delivered by the applicant to be accepted. By adding them to the list, the applicant confirms he/she has personally presented them.
- ✓ Published abstracts are not awarded points and should not be listed.
- ✓ Only presentations given at international, national, and regional scientific events are accepted.
- ✓ Presentations at hospital departmental meetings and events organised by pharmaceutical companies are not accepted and should not be listed.
Speeches or lectures given at courses/workshops/task force meetings are not accepted and should not be listed.
- ✓ Presentations to be held in the future do not give points (even if already accepted) and should not be listed.

First or last author receives 20 points per publication; any other place on the authors' list receives 10 points.
