

Skin Cancer Masterclass

Residents Course | 11 May 2022 | Ljubljana, Slovenia

Description

This intense full-day course aims to provide basic and practical knowledge on the diagnosis and treatment of skin cancers. The sessions will cover management of melanoma, keratinocyte cancers (actinic keratosis, squamous cell carcinoma and basal cell carcinoma) and other rare skin cancers (Merkel cell carcinoma, Kaposi sarcoma, cutaneous lymphomas). The teaching program will bring up-to-date guidelines and evidence-based practice, provided by a panel of European leading experts in the field of onco-dermatology. Pre-course training materials will be provided to participants before attending the live lectures, to optimise their learning experience. The live courses will consist in 20-minutes lectures focusing on key points highlighted by experts on each topic, combined with three interactive roundtables bringing up together speakers and attendees. These unique roundtables will allow participants to test their diagnostic knowledge based on «dermoscopy quizzes» and allow speakers to share their experience around real-life case studies selected from their practice. Post-course online tests will allow attendees to test their knowledge and skills acquired during the training.

- Identify skin cancers based on clinical and dermoscopy features
- Guide the management of skin cancers according to updated European guidelines
- Recognise complex situations and discuss different strategies based on case studies
