

# Virology and the Skin

Resident and specialist Course | 28-30 November 2022 | Porto, Portugal

## Description

This course presents all the viral mucocutaneous diseases, from virologic aspects to epidemiology, pathomechanisms, typical and atypical clinical manifestations, diagnostic techniques, management of patients and treatments. This course will also address the emerging viral skin diseases, such as the Dengue virus, the Covid 19 and the monkey pox. The course will also review the dermatopathological aspects of these mucocutaneous viral infections, based on a theoretical course and hands-on session.

You will be asked to present a short case (PowerPoint presentation, maximum 5 min) that will be discussed with the expert panel.

2. Learn how to prescribe, use and perform the recommended diagnostic techniques for viral skin diseases
3. Understand what are the optimal treatment(s) to prescribe for viral skin diseases
