## **Course Description**

Neuromodulators based on the A strain of Botulinum Toxin (BoNT-A) were first introduced into the aesthetic arena in the early 1990s. Their cosmetic use is now firmly entrenched and has classically been limited to the softening of undesirable dynamic facial lines, pathognomonic of the aging face. The true mandate of the cosmetic physician, however, is to strike beyond rejuvenation into the realm of beauty maximization.

The Botulinum Toxin course aims to give participants from A to Z all the necessary information, starting from appropriate patient selection, preparing the right dilution of B.T, selecting appropriate syringes and needles, targeting and injecting the ideal part of the treating muscle to perfecting the technique.

Three experts of the Botulinum Toxin injections will share with the participants their experience and will try to reveal all the "secrets" of the procedure.

## **Learning Objectives**

- 1. Identify the right patient, address the appropriate indication, discuss the expectation from the procedure as well as provide the basic anatomical information necessary for the treatment.
- 2. Perfect the technique from the beginning (syringes and needles, points of injection, how to make the injection as painless as possible) until the end (after-treatment movements advice, beneficial effects, frequency of the injections).
- 3. Recognize common pitfalls and how to avoid complications
