Description

The Therapeutics in Hair Loss and Hair Transplant course offers an update on the diagnostic and therapeutic approach to hair loss patients. From the diagnostic approach of the alopecia to the current use of treatments. The integrated management of alopecia patients is discussed during this 3-day course held in a Unit of Trichology of a Dermatology Department.

The programme includes:

- Update sessions on diagnostic and therapeutic topics,
- Hands-on workshops on therapeutic procedures,
- Discussion sessions on clinical cases provided/presented by the participants.

The course also aims at sharing the experiences of other centres in the management of alopecia areata patients.

Finally, participants will benefit of an outstanding networking opportunity with other European dermatologists dedicated to hair loss patients' management.

Learning Objectives

1. To review the diagnostic approach to hair loss, based on clinical and trichoscopic features, applied to clinical practice.
2. Become familiar with the commonest treatments in non-cicatricial alopecia, like androgenetic alopecia and alopecia areata. Know how best to individualize the clinical management.
3. Make therapeutic decisions in challenging cases of cicatricial alopecia by integrating the available treatments and after an adequate assessment of the risks and benefits of each of the options.
4. Transfer to clinical practice the skills acquired on therapeutics procedures for hair loss patients.
