COURSE DESCRIPTION

The “HPV on the Cutting Edge of Dermatology and Venereology” course is organized by the EADV HPV Task Force.

- global burden and epidemiology
- oncogenic aspects
- the specific role of dermatovenereologist in the diagnostic approach and patients' management
- vaccination's benefits
