Course Description

This course is aimed at skilled surgeons needing to improve technique for reconstructions in difficult anatomical areas. The aim is to learn, manage and practice flaps for face periorificial areas.

The course is spread over 3 days and consists of different lectures, including discussions, interactive sessions and practical parts where participants will have the opportunity to experience live demonstration of surgery on cadavers.

Day 1: Theoretical part for anatomy and reconstructive options of face unit.

Day 2 and 3: Practical session on human cadaver head of selected flap. Participants will be paired and both will perform the technique as 1st and 2nd operator.

At the beginning of the course all participants will make a short evaluation of their needs and at the end of the event they will discuss what they have learnt.

Learning Objectives

- 1) Plan properly dermatologic surgery reconstruction according to anatomical location
- 2) Be aware of the anatomical possible risks and complications and their prevention or management
- 3) Perform more complex repairs in surgery
