Description

Knowledge of Tropical Dermatology is becoming increasingly important in the dermatology clinics of Europe due to imported skin diseases from either returning travellers or incoming migrants/refugees.

With the current worldwide migration, the issue of tropical knowledge is especially acute.

The course will address this specific need as well as equipping the European dermato-venereologist with skills to take out to tropics, as well as resource poor destinations.

The Tropical Dermatology course is organized by the members of the EADV Task Force on Tropical Dermatology.

- 2. Acquire knowledge and skills to diagnose and treat skin conditions in returning travellers or migrants
