3.1 Hybrid format

The EADV Congress 2024 will organise its core activities and educational focus onsite but will continue to maintain its educational platform online, making the congress **a hybrid event**.

- The platform will remain open for a duration of 3 months with all on-demand content

- All EADV sessions will be live-streamed and made available on-demand
- All EADV speakers will be present onsite
- Opportunity to have session interactivity onsite and virtually
- No parallel virtual events will be allowed

5 PATIENT ORGANISATION AREA LOCATION, SETUP and FORMAT

5.1 Location of the Patient Organisation Area

The Patient Orgnisation area will be in Hall 2. The floor plans of the congress venue will be found in the Final Programme brochure published on the EADV Congress website closer to the Events date.

5.2 Patient Organisation Area set-up

The shred area is equipped with 5 desks with 2 high stools each. Behind each desk there will be a screen used to display the logo of the Patient Organisation present at the desk during the assigned timeslot. If preferred, instead of the logo, a slide-deck of maximum 3 slides can be displayed running in the background. In both cases, a 16:9 logo or PowerPoint must be provided. Each desk also has a 22' screen, to which a laptop can be connected to display additional digital material.

<u>Material:</u> The EADV is committed to reducing the carbon footprint of the annual congress. As part of this effort, the EADV is no longer allowing flyers, roll-up banners, any other printed support. We recommend bringing your laptop with your digital material to be displayed during your exhibition time.

5.3 Patient Organisation Area format

Each participating Patient Organisation is to be present at the area for 2 hours a day (Wednesday to Saturday) according to pre-allocated slots.

All Patients Organisation Representatives have access to the EADV scientific sessions. Industry sessions may be limited to HCP only.

<u>Meetings:</u>

No designated meeting area exists, but nearby the Patient Organisation Area several seating areas are available.

Please ensure that one representative of your organisation is present at the Patient Organisation Area during the assigned timeslot.

6 PATIENT REPRESETATIVES REGISTRATION PASS

6.1 In general

Each participating Patient Organisation is entitled to 3 complimentary tickets granting access to the EADV Congress. For Patient Organisations attending only virtually, the ticket will be limited to virtual attendance only.

The EADV will contact you to share the registration form once your Patient Organisation application has been accepted.

6.2 Important Note to Healthcare and Non-Healthcare Professionals

A multidisciplinary audience will attend the EADV Congress, and the EADV will assign different classes to healthcare professionals (HCP) and non-Healthcare Professionals (non-HCP) to ensure compliance with these regulations.

All delegates, including Patient Organisation Representatives must indicate whether they are Healthcare Professionals or not at registration.

Access to the different areas and sessions of the Congress depends on the delegate's status as a Healthcare Professional or a Non-Healthcare Professional.

According to the Dutch code, patients and patient representatives are considered non-HCPs and must not be exposed to promotional content.

The exhibition area, the Industry Meeting Area (Hall 5), the Industry Expert Hubs and several Industry Satellite Symposia are restricted to HCP only.

Industry sessions

Satellite Symposia and Industry Hub Sessions presenting data on the development, research, or other issues related to prescription medicine is restricted to Healthcare Professionals and Industry Participants as indicated by the Industry Session Organizer. All promotional materials and marketing aids related to these industry sessions should be strictly limited to HCPs. Industry Session organisers can limit participation to certain representative groups independently from the EADV recommendations if deemed imperative to achieving the session's intended purpose. The organising company reserves the right to refuse single categories, particularly if they are not adequately related to the session's objective and purpose.

The industry session organiser is responsible for compliance with the session.

EUR 20 will be charged to the participant for the change of status from "Non-Healthcare Professional" to "Healthcare professional" (and vice versa).
