

Cutaneous Lymphoma

Residents Course | 03-05 February 2025 | Bordeaux, France

Description

This course will present a practical overview of cutaneous lymphoma including diagnostic criteria, staging adapted to the type of lymphoma, and treatments. Learners will be able to see the clinical reasoning skills necessary for the optimal management strategy personalized for a patient with cutaneous lymphomas, at various courses of the diseases.

Recent data concerning new entities, new therapies and guidelines, translational research, and international prospective prognostic studies will be presented.

The course will alternate classical presentations and interactive sessions with slide analysis, case-based diagnostic and therapeutic discussions.

Learning Objectives

1. Learn which investigations are useful for diagnosis and initial workup, depending on the type of clinically suspected cutaneous lymphoma.
2. Understand the therapeutic strategy for cutaneous lymphoma and know when to use innovative treatments
3. Know the evolution and prognostic factors of cutaneous lymphoma according to subtype
