

Dermoscopy Summer Workshop

Residents & Specialists Course | 23-27 June 2025 | Vis, Croatia

Description

The course will provide the analytic learning of dermoscopy with the implementation of specific vocabulary used in dermoscopy, as well as the adequate use of different types of dermoscopic devices. Participants will learn dermoscopic criteria, rules and algorithms for diagnosing various benign and malignant skin lesions, as well as inflammatory dermatoses, including trichoscopy and onychoscopy. Each day of the course many interactive cases will be analyzed and discussed with participants following each new topic. Course will include a pre- and post-teaching evaluation.

Learning Objectives

- 1. Learn dermoscopic features and algorithms, differentiate melanocytic from non-melanocytic lesions of the skin and mucous membranes, detect suspicious skin lesion, determine the lesion that needs to be removed from the ones that do not or just need follow up.
- 2. Learn how and when to use digital dermoscopy
- 3. Apply the acquired knowledge in dermoscopy in everyday practice, both in diagnosing skin tumours and inflammatory dermatoses
- 4. Apply dermoscopy in diagnosing dermatological conditions on the skin, mucous membranes, nail unit and scalp.
