Course Description

The course “Genital HPV from Paediatric to Mature Age” offers a comprehensive update on all aspects of anogenital Human Papillomavirus (HPV) infections, providing participants with essential knowledge and practical skills to effectively manage HPV across the lifespan, ensuring optimal patient care and outcomes.

With expert speakers and leading professionals in the field (members of the EADV HPV Task Force), the course aims to deliver a well-rounded understanding of HPV’s epidemiology, oncogenic risks, and clinical management in various patient populations.

The programme is structured around interactive lectures and clinical sessions. Participants, divided in small groups, will have the opportunity to observe treatment procedures performed in the Sexually Transmitted Unit of Piemonte Regional Health Service.
