

## Dermoscopy in Clinical Practice

Combined Course (Residents + Specialists) | 16-17 January 2026 | Vienna, Austria

### Description

This is a two-day interactive dermoscopy course discussing various aspects of use of dermoscopy in everyday practice, aiming at orientation of dermatologists who have not received dermoscopy training during their residency and sharpening specialists' skills with updated scientific data.

### Learning Objectives

Following this course, the attendee should be able to:

- ✓ Introduce dermoscopy, highlighting the underlying physics, different types of dermoscopy, and types and modalities of usage.
- ✓ Discuss typical and atypical dermoscopic findings in various dermatoses, with the purpose of making the participants confident in diagnosing different lesions.
- ✓ Address difficult to diagnose lesions highlighting the difference between closely looking alike lesions, in addition to special sites, situations and populations.
