Course description: The “Tropical Dermatology” course is organized by the EADV Taskforce Tropical Dermatology.

Knowledge of Tropical Dermatology is becoming increasingly important in the dermatology clinics of Europe due to imported skin diseases from either returning travellers or incoming migrants/refugees. With the current worldwide migration, the issue of tropical knowledge is especially acute. The course will address this specific need as well as equipping the European dermatovenereologist with skills to take out to tropics as well as resource poor destinations
