

## HOW TO PREPARE YOUR LIST OF PUBLICATIONS

### Instructions to applicants:

Please read these instructions carefully before starting your application.

Only lists of publications that are properly completed, self-scored and uploaded within the deadline will be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to follow the criteria for scholarship application and ensure that the information provided in the application form is truthful and accurate.

The applicant has to mention clearly in the list of publications if her/his surname has changed over her/his training/publication period.

Evaluation of EADV scholarship applications is made on the basis of an objective assessment of the applicant's scientific activities. The list of publications has to be presented in numerical order (i.e., 1..., 2..., 3...)

Points are awarded according to the following scoring system:

	1 <sup>st</sup> or last author (Number of points)	Any other place in the authors' list (Number of points)
<b>Paper published in a journal indexed in PubMed</b>	10	5
<b>Book or chapter published by an international publisher</b>	8	4
<b>Paper published in a journal NOT indexed in PubMed</b>	5	2.5
<b>Book or chapter published by a national publisher</b>	4	2
<b>Poster or oral presentation presented in an international congress</b>	1	0
<b>Poster or oral presentation presented in a national congress</b>	0.5	0

To be eligible to apply:

- Trainee or certified specialist in Dermatology and/or Venereology: A minimum of 5 points are required.
- PhD Students or Scientists already holding a PhD degree in Dermatology and/or Venereology and/or Cutaneous Biology-related sciences are required to reach a minimum of 25 points.

Only fully and properly described references must be included in the evaluation process: full details of other authors, title of article, journal name, page number(s) have to be displayed.

Only articles and books that have been published will be accepted. Contributions that have been submitted or are 'in press' (including e-publications) but have not yet been published by the time of application will not be accepted (unless you can provide the DOI/ISBN number). Web publications are not accepted.

Poster and oral presentations will be given points only if the applicant was the first or last author and only such presentations should be included in the application. In both cases, the full list of authors must be included. Active participation in international, national, and regional scientific events should be included with 'Oral' or 'Poster' presentations.

Only presentations made at international, national, and regional scientific events will be accepted. Other presentations e.g., at hospital departmental meetings and events organised by pharmaceutical companies will not be accepted.

Presentations to be held in the future cannot be added (even if already accepted).

Full details of all authors, title of presentation, full name of conference (avoid abbreviations), venue and dates, must be given.

For each record it has to be specified whether the presentation was an oral or poster presentation.

In case of oral presentations, the presentation must have been made personally by the applicant to be accepted and, therefore, it should be indicated clearly that the presentation was in fact made personally by him/her.

Published abstracts are not awarded points and should not be listed.

First or last author receives 10 points per publication; any other place on the authors' list receives 5 points.
